The applicant must be graduating (or have graduated) from secondary school and plan to attend (or are currently attending) full-time courses at an accredited Canadian University, College or Technical School. The VGE member must be in good standing with the Vancouver Grain Exchange.

The scholarships are for one year and can be reapplied for on a yearly basis. The total amount of the scholarships this year is \$10,000 to be divided among the chosen applicants.
